Greetings from LaSalle, Colorado!

We would like to welcome you to LaSalle Day 2009 on July 11<sup>th</sup>. In the main park booths, games, and various activities will be scheduled throughout the day.

Activities in the park will begin at 11:00am and will continue until 5:00pm. **The cost of a booth will be as follows: No cost for civic and non-profit groups, \$10 for town residents, and \$20 for out of town residents (please make checks payable to the Town of LaSalle).** Electricity is available for an additional \$20 and is limited. Remember you are responsible for providing your own tables, chairs, shade, extension cords, etc. Since the LaSalle Lions Club will be providing lunch, we ask that vendors only sell snack food and only after 2:00p.m. (this excludes shaved ice, snow cones, etc.) Vendors serving food items must complete a Weld County Temporary/Special Event application. **Attention Vendors!! Items such as: Fire Crackers, Silly String, Champaign Poppers, Smoke and Stink Bombs, Snap-N-Pops, and Explosion Bags are prohibited for sale or use in LaSalle Parks.**

LaSalle Day will run smoothly by following these simple rules:

- 1. NO PARKING OR DRIVING ON THE GRASS . NO EXCEPTIONS !**
2. No Advertisement for food sale until after 2:00p.m.
3. All trash must be picked up and placed in trashcans or dumpsters.
4. No animals in the park.
5. Vendors may not solicit business beyond the boundaries of the booth.
6. No loud music due to other performances.

We will post a map with booth numbers at the restrooms, which are centrally located at the park. We will display booth numbers in the park after 7:00am on July 11<sup>th</sup>. You may set your booth up anytime after 7:00a.m. and you must tear down your booth by 6:00p.m.
